

AN ACT to name a certain bridge
in Chattanooga as the "Clarence
B. Robinson Memorial Bridge", and
to direct the department of
transportation to erect
appropriate markers.

WHEREAS, Representative Clarence B. Robinson has made
notable contributions to the Chattanooga area and the state of
Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Representative Robinson has been a valuable leader
in the Tennessee General Assembly since 1974; and

WHEREAS, Representative Robinson has been a dedicated public
servant for many years as a humanitarian and civil rights leader
and a tireless civic worker; and

WHEREAS, C.B. is a loving husband and father; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to honor Clarence B. Robinson
for his central role in the history of the city of Chattanooga
and the state of Tennessee; now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The Amnicola Bridge spanning the Tennessee River
in Chattanooga is hereby designated the "Clarence B. Robinson
Memorial Bridge".

SECTION 2. The department of transportation is directed
to erect appropriate markers at each end of the bridge.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1981, the
Public welfare requiring it.
